What to Expect in Class

New music, new activities every 4 weeks. Click [here](#) to read a description of all the fun themes we'll experience in class and at home.



Gathering Time. The first 5 to 10 minutes of class will be used to purposefully come together. Soft music will be playing and there are books, instruments and other developmentally appropriate materials on the floor for you and baby to explore. This is our time to greet, affirm, visit and get acquainted with one another while we are settling in for class.

Singing & Vocalization. Our goal is to provide a musical setting for baby and caregiver that is advantageous to joyful, spontaneous singing and vocalizing.

Listening. We'll "bathe" baby in a variety of sounds—with the intent of building a sound repertoire, motivating vocal play, fostering some level of attention toward sounds, laying ground work for sound memory, while all along recognizing that baby has sound preferences.

Instrument & Object Play. Baby will have ample time within a multi-sensory environment to discover, engage with, and experience an instrument or object with the goal of better understanding the physical properties of the object as well as learning how to manipulate it.

Movement. Your baby is learning through moving and being moved in space. That's why we provide the optimal learning environment for her to practice and internalize movement for brain development, overall physical health, body awareness and to experience social interactions with other adults and toddlers.

Language Development. Our carefully planned and research-based activities stimulate an understanding of words and expands vocabulary development; grow baby's love for books and the printed word; develop a repertoire of sign language that can be used to support the conversation between baby and caring adult throughout the day.

Pretend Play. Our class environment supports pretend play, helping toddlers better understand their world and to develop a sense of security, accomplished through imitation, repetition, expression of feelings, the development of early communication skills, all while building relationships that support self-esteem and self-confidence.

Hello and Goodbye Routines. We'll provide a predictable beginning and end to the Kindermusik class experience. This eases anxiety, increases self-awareness and helps to focus your child for learning.

Directions for New Families:

Registering for Kindermusik@Home is easy, it takes less than a minute, *and* provides access to your materials on computers, mobile devices, and tablets.

1. When you receive the email from Kindermusik Int'l, click on the link to my.kindermusik.com.
2. Select "New User."
3. Enter name and email address, using the same email address as on the email received from Kindermusik.
4. Set a password and security questions.
5. Click on "Create Account" then "Log in!"

KINDERMUSIK@HOME TRICKS & TIPS

1. **ADD KINDERMUSIK@HOME TO YOUR HOME SCREEN.** That way, you don't have to log in in every time you want to play with your digital materials, read a story, or listen to your music on the audio player. Here's how...

Go to my.kindermusik.com on your internet browser (no http:// prefix), then...

- **BLACKBERRY:** Tap the little heart with the plus sign on it.
- **ANDROID:** Tap the menu button on the bottom left of the phone (not the screen). Select "Add Shortcut to Home Screen".
- **APPLE:** Tap  then select "Add to Home Screen"

- 2. LISTEN TO YOUR MUSIC, ANYTIME, ANYWHERE!** Log in to Kindermusik@Home or just tap the icon (if you've added it to your home screen as above), select the unit you want, and tap **AUDIO PLAYER**. Your music will automatically stream to your device! No need to burn CDs... Hooray!!

Important Stuff...

Parent/caregiver Involvement: Always sing and participate enthusiastically in class. Use your teacher as your model and choose a way to do the activities with your child that matches his/her developmental level and personality. Our motto is FOLLOW THE CHILD!

What to bring: Dress lightly and comfortably, since we will be moving around a fair bit and the room tends to get a little warm. We have a "No Shoes Policy" in the studio. You may leave your footwear and outerwear in the foyer. Please bring all valuables into the classroom and leave everything else, including car seats, soothers, bottles, and snacks in our gathering area. Ensure your child's bare feet are accessible for activities involving the stimulation of his/her toes and soles of the feet. It's also helpful to **bring a small blanket to class each week**.

What if my child is sick? If you, or your child, have a fever, please wait until he/she is fever-free for 24 hours before returning to class. If your child has suffered a stomach bug or has thrown up within the last 24 hours please keep them at home. If your child has a severe cough, thick nasal discharge, rash or conjunctivitis please let them rest at home.

Yes, we have unlimited classes! Rest assured you can make up a missed class anytime by taking advantage of our unlimited classes policy. Feel free to join us in any age-appropriate class as availability allows. No need to book ahead, or call us. Just take a look at our [schedule online](#) at the classes that are running for your child's age group and drop in! (Be sure to look at the classes on page 2 as well, as they may not appear in order by age group.)

Communication: Communications and information will be distributed by email, in class, or will be available for pick up at the studio. Please note that due to road construction, from August to November access to/from the studio is from Sheldon Drive West (Hespeler Road) only. You will not be able to access it from Franklin Blvd. We apologize for any inconvenience caused.

Payment policies: Payments are processed monthly, September to June, for as long as you are enrolled. Monthly payments may be made by one of the following methods.

1. Preauthorized VISA or MasterCard; OR
2. Bring to your first class post-dated cheques in the amount of \$65 + HST = \$73.45 each, and dated the 5th of each month, from the current month to June.

Please ensure that your account info is complete and your payment method is selected by visiting "[My Account](#)" now. Any payments for registrations received after the 5th of the month will be processed at the time of registration.

Withdrawal Policy: If enrollment must be cancelled, any fees paid are non-refundable and the [Withdrawal Request Form](#) must be received by the office prior to the 1st day of your last month in order for your request to be processed. You will be contacted via email by our administrator to confirm this change. Note that it does not take effect until you have received confirmation from the administrator. The materials are yours to keep and enjoy.

For any classes you are unable to attend, there is no cash value and they cannot be transferred to the enrollment of a sibling. You may, however, make them up prior to the end of your enrollment and you have until the end of your last month to do so. *Should you decide to withdraw for a period of time, your space cannot be held. In this case, you are better to keep your space and take advantage of our new unlimited classes offer to make up the classes you will be missing.*

SAFE & RESPECTFUL: These two principles are of utmost importance to us and the families in our care. We have the right to terminate any enrollment where an individual is consistently unable to uphold them.
