



Kindermusik® Summer Camps for Babies

♪ Parent/Caregiver Involvement:

For the sake of preserving the quality of every child's experience in Kindermusik, we greatly appreciate your efforts in making childcare arrangements for all siblings not enrolled in the program. At least one parent or caregiver per child is needed to participate in each class. Always sing and participate enthusiastically in class. Use your teacher as your model and choose a way to do the activity with your child that matches his/her developmental level.

♪ What to Bring:

Please be sure to bring a small blanket with you each week to class. Dress lightly and comfortably, since we will be moving around a fair bit and the room tends to get a little warm. Please ensure your baby's bare feet are accessible for activities involving the stimulation of his/her toes and soles of the feet. We have a "No Shoes Policy" in the studio. You may leave your footwear and outerwear in the designated area. Please bring all valuables into the classroom and leave everything else, including car seats, soothers, bottles, and snacks in our waiting area. We do have a baby-changing station in our washroom for your convenience.

♪ Payment:

Full payment is required on or before the first day of class. Payments may be made online, mailed, phoned-in, or dropped off. Our office hours are Monday to Thursday, 8:00 am to 4:00pm. Please notify the office immediately if you need to transfer to a class other than the one for which you originally registered.

♪ Materials:

At the first class, each family will receive a set of *At-Home Materials*. Be sure to open them up right away and use them often. You will find your baby will participate more readily if the activities we do in class continue at home. We believe that you are your child's most important teacher. Together with your teacher's guidance in class and the materials at home, you will have the capability to create an optimal learning experience for your baby.

♪ Fall Classes:

If you haven't already registered for fall classes, you may do so any time during the week. Registration forms and information about each curriculum are available in the waiting room and on our website. You may register online at www.kindermusikcambridgekw.com or you can complete a printed form and give it to your child's teacher or hand in at the office.
