## Courtesy Information

1. Please return promptly for the last 30 minutes of class (10:30 a.m.) for a **Family Sharing Time**. The teacher will invite you in when it is time. We will be sharing some games, instrument play and songs as well as making a craft. Siblings of any age are welcome to attend the Sharing Time, but please be courteous of others and remove a disruptive child for a brief “time out”.
2. We have a “No Shoes Policy” in the studio. You may leave your footwear in the entranceway.
3. On the first day of class, your child will receive a paper tote bag. Please bring this bag each day so that your child may add some new stickers to it and use it for carrying items to and from class.
4. Your child’s home materials will be distributed on the first day of class. You do not need to bring any of these items to class. They include the following:
  - **On The Road Home CD**. Please play this CD as much as possible during the week so that your child becomes familiar with the songs. You can also download the music at <http://play.kindermusik.com/>. Just click on “Register” in the top right corner to access.
  - **Go Van Go! Literature Book**. We will be reading this book in class each day. The book details the adventures of the Flugelhorn Family as they experience a road trip together. Please enjoy re-reading the book at home and relating it to your child’s own experiences.
  - **Parent Poster**. On the poster, you will find additional things to do with your child at home each day, information about the musical focus in class that day and additional story time books you may wish to read to your child that relate to the theme of the day.
  - **Frog Guiro**. This wooden instrument makes a realistic frog sound. **It will be distributed on the second day after we have used them in class.**
5. Your child is welcome to bring any articles that pertain to the daily theme (see below for daily themes).
6. We would absolutely LOVE to see you back in the Fall! If you haven’t already registered don’t delay as classes are filling up!
