



WELCOME TO “TELL ME A TALE”! COURTESY INFORMATION

1. Please return promptly for the last 15 minutes of class (11:30 a.m.) for a **Family Sharing Time**. The teacher will invite you in when it is time. We will be sharing information about the folk tale of the day, playing instruments and singing. Siblings of any age are welcome to attend the Sharing Time, but please be courteous of others and remove a disruptive child for a brief “time out” if needed.
2. We have a “No Shoes Policy” in the studio. You may leave your footwear in the entranceway.
3. On the first day, your child will receive a paper bag for transporting things to and from class. Please bring this bag each day.
4. Your child’s home materials will be distributed on the first day of class. You do not need to bring any of these items to class. They include the following:
 - **Tell Me A Tale Home CD**. Please play this CD as much as possible during the week so that your child becomes familiar with the songs. You can also download the music at <http://play.kindermusik.com/>. Just click on “Register” in the top right corner to access.
 - **Tell Me A Tale Literature Book**. This book has all the folk tales that we will be doing each day in order. Please enjoy re-reading the folk tale of the day together.
 - **Parent Poster**. On the poster, you will find additional things to do with your child at home each day, information about the musical focus in class that day and additional story time books you may wish to read to your child that relate to the theme of the day.
 - **Lummi Sticks Instrument (1 pair)**
5. If your child will have difficulty leaving you on the first day, you are more than welcome to stay with your child until he/she feels comfortable. Please do not hesitate to talk to the teacher about any concerns you may have.
