1. We have a “No Shoes Policy” in the studio. You may leave your footwear in the entranceway.
2. On the first day of camp, your child will receive a paper tote bag for transporting things to and from class. Please bring this bag each day as your child will be bringing some items home daily.
3. Your child’s home materials will be distributed on the first day of class. You do not need to bring any of these items to class. They include the following:
 - **Zoo Train Home CD.** Please play this CD as much as possible during the week so that your child becomes familiar with the songs. You can also download the music at <http://play.kindermusik.com/>. Just click on “Register” in the top right corner to access.
 - **Zoo Train! Literature Book.** We will be reading this book in class each day. This book details the fun adventures of the Allee-Alle-O train as it meets various animals at the zoo. Please enjoy re-reading the story together at home.
 - **Parent Poster.** On the poster, you will find additional things to do with your child at home each day, information about the musical focus in class that day and additional story time books you may wish to read to your child that relate to the theme of the day.
 - **Animal Shaker.** Your child will receive either a giraffe or an elephant shaker.
4. Please leave all toys and stuffed animals at home as your child will need their hands for all of the activities.
5. Please be prepared to attend class for the full hour with your child. This curriculum is designed to be a one-on-one experience with your child. Baby-sitting will need to be arranged for other siblings. Kindermusik is not responsible for unsupervised children.
6. We would absolutely LOVE to see you back in the Fall! If you haven’t already registered don’t delay as classes are filling up!
